CHIEF JUDGE ANNOUNCES LIMITED COURTHOUSE HOURS

DuPage County Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin has issued an Administrative Order effective March 30, 2020 prohibiting entry into the DuPage County Courthouse after 3:00 p.m., except for courthouse employees. The Order is in effect until April 17, 2020 and may be modified as necessary in response to the Coronavirus pandemic.

“We are still conducting essential governmental functions and court business in the courthouse each day under a limited, restructured schedule. However, there is an overriding public health and safety interest in reasonably restricting entry into the courthouse. This Order serves to balance that interest while still ensuring effective and efficient access to justice for essential court business”, stated Chief Judge Guerin.

The Circuit Court Clerk will provide a drop box at the Courthouse entrance for any time-sensitive, essential court filings. Any such filings will be collected and processed each day by the Clerk’s Office.
