IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Order M.R. 30370 dated March 20, 2020 and as amended on April 3, 2020, Administrative Order 2020-7 entered March 25, 2020 is amended and superceded as follows:

Trials are continued until further order from the Illinois Supreme Court. In the case of criminal proceedings, any delay resulting from this emergency continuance order shall not be attributable to either the State or the defendant for purposes of Section 103-5 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 (725 ILCS 5/103-5 (West 2018)). In the case of juvenile delinquency proceedings, any delay resulting from this emergency continuance order shall not be attributable to either the State or the juvenile for purposes of Section 5-601 of the Illinois Juvenile Court Act (705 ILCS 405/5-601 (West 2018)).
