EXTENSION OF COVID-19 ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS AND PROTOCOLS

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to cause deaths and illnesses in Will County, the State of Illinois and throughout the world;

WHEREAS, concerns for the spread of COVID-19 demand that the public, Court employees and all others doing business in the judicial facilities in the Twelfth Judicial Circuit take all necessary precautions against contracting the virus;


WHEREAS, both the State and Federal Governments continue to require social distancing, stay at home orders and other measures designed to slow the spread of the virus;

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit has issued Administrative Orders 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-11, 2020-12, 2020-13 and 2020-14 setting forth protocols for limiting Court appearances to only those situations where the Constitution or exigent circumstances so demand;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the protocols and procedures set forth in Administrative Orders 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-11, 2020-12, 2020-13 and 2020-14 are continued until May 15, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. In addition, any and all protocols developed to address the pandemic that are not Administrative Orders are likewise continued.

This Order is effective immediately.
