### **ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT PRETRIAL PRACTICES COMMISSION TO HOST PUBLIC HEARINGS**

The Illinois Supreme Court Commission on Pretrial Practices will host a series of public hearings as it works towards its final report and recommendations in December 2019. The Commission recently released its preliminary report concerning pretrial reform in the Illinois criminal justice system. A final report with recommendations regarding the administration of pretrial justice in Illinois will be released in December 2019.
