EXTENSION OF COVID-19 ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS AND PROTOCOLS

WHEREAS, the public health emergency involving COVID-19 continues to cause fatalities and illness throughout the world;

WHEREAS, Governor J.B. Pritzker has extended his Executive Order until May 29, 2020 requiring individuals to stay at home and placing restrictions on businesses and other entities in order to slow the spread of COVID-19 ;


WHEREAS, the Twelfth Judicial Circuit continues to take all necessary measures to reduce the risk of contracting the virus for the public, employees and those doing business in judicial facilities;

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit has issued Administrative Orders 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-11, 2020-12, 2020-13, 2020-14, 2020-15 and 2020-16 limiting in-person Court appearances and expanding the use of technology so that personal attendance in Court only occurs where the Constitution or exigent circumstances so demand;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the protocols and procedures set forth in Administrative Orders 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-11, 2020-12, 2020-13, 2020-14, 2020-15 and 2020-16 are continued until May 29, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. In addition, any and all protocols developed to address the pandemic that are not Administrative Orders are likewise continued.

This Order is effective immediately.
